Begins with fine weather
Employed in caulking and
repairing the Landward Boats
at 12 mid night further trying
Latter part Calm
Lat obs 33 15 N

Thursday
The 14th
291^{out}

Begins with Calm
Lard Pompesey & Blackfish
Employed in Repairing the
Landward Boat
Day ends with fine weather
Lat obs 32 21 N

Friday
The 15th
292^{out}

May D 1829
Begins with fine weather
Wind S W Standing to the
Southward
at 3 P M saw a large Whale
to leeward towed all the Boat
and after great exertions I
got long side of him
But lost him by having a man
that cant fasten to a Whale
more than once with 3 times
going long side of them
and having more better to
take his place in the Boat
Latter part Employed in Repairing
the Landward Boats
Lat obs 32 24 N

Saturday
The 16th
293^{out}

through the day fine weather
and moderate breeze from
S E and heavy swell
from S W
Lat obs 32 54 N
