 The 23
 299 out through the day pleasant
 weather and fine breeze from
 the S. ward at 6 AM finished
 repairing the harbor boat
 latter part employed in
 repairing the fore top sail
 and fore top of the
 Lat obs 32 52 N
 Long by obs 0 176 31 W

Sunday Begins with fine weather
 The 24 Wind to the S. E. standing
 300 out to the W. ward by the wind
 with only employed in repairing the fore
 top sail latter part light shower
 of rain Wind S. E. standing to
 S. W. Lat obs 32 31 N
 Long obs 0 179 12 W

Monday at meridian, saw sperm whale
 The 25 at 2 PM landed all the boats
 301 out and after a long chase
 I got long side of a large
 one and fastened but lost my
 line by the whale swimming

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 and 2 more and on land
 Chased the whale till sundown
 and then returns on board
 at 6 PM saw whale but lost
 sight of them soon
 at 10 PM saw black fish &
 Porpoise Lat obs 32 25 N

Tuesday Begins with fine weather
 The 26 and light air from the S. W.
 302 out and S. W. saw a large
 Porpoise in the water seen 3 miles
 of middle part Calm
 latter part fine breeze from
 S. W. Lat obs 32 25 N
 Long obs 0 179 12 W

Wednesday Begins with fine weather and
 The 27 pleasant breeze from S. W.
 303 out saw a sail to windward
 taken to be E. S. E.
 Employed in stowing down oil
 in the main hatch way
 Lat 32 25 N
