 The 2^d Begins with thick squally
 304^{out} weather Wind at N
 Wore Ship to the E Ward
 and double Reeped the
 top Sails Lat obs 32° 45' N
 Friday Begins with strong gales from
 the S E with thick weather
 305^{out} at 4 P M took in sail &
 Lay by under the main Top sail
 Day Ends N E obs
 Saturday Begins with a gale from the
 30^{out} N, Laying to under the main
 306^{out} top sail at 2 A M Wore Ship
 to the E S E.
 Latter part more moderate
 Let the fore sail
 Lat obs 32° 34' N
 Sunday Begins with strong gales
 the 31 from the N N W
 307^{out} Wore Ship to the W Ward
 Lat obs at 11 A M saw sperm whale
 32-31 N and in chase of them

Monday June 1829
 The 1st Begins with strong breeze from
 the N Ward and a heavy sea
 308^{out} from N N W
 at 1 P M fastened to a large
 whale and killed him at
 2 De got him long side
 and got all Reddy & Butt
 through the Right heavy sea
 and almost calm
 at 5 A M began cutting
 at 11 got the head of after
 my getting hurt with a blow
 and losing our blubber hook
 and 1 Spade by the strap
 Putting the Lee side to heavy
 that I am obliged to Run
 to the South ward to Cut
 at meridian got aft in but
 the head
 Lat obs 32° 12' N
