 The 5th Begins with strong breezes
 340th out from the S Standing to the
 E and Employed in gaging
 Irons &c &c
 Latter part light breeze from
 the S.W. Standing to the S.E.
 Employed in setting up Shooks &c
 Lat obs 34-11

Saturday Begins with light breeze from
 the S.W. Standing to the S.E.
 341th out at 5 P.M. Sailed a ship to the
 Sward at 10 A.M. Spoke the ship
 the Eagle of N. took
 9 marks out 500 barrels
 Lat obs 33 38 S
 Long obs 176 39 W

Sunday through the day fine weather
 the 5th Wind S.W. at 2 P.M. Sailed a
 Lat obs Dead Whail the Eagle at Point
 33 29 S took her to my ship and cut
 Long her in and I divided the Blue
 obs 176 35 as I had noted for the day
 by 8th at 7 P.M. Separated and I did
 342th out to the Sward

Monday July 1829
 The 6th Begins with fine weather
 343th out Wind at S.W. Standing to the
 S.W. by W by the Wind
 Saw Squid & Black fish and
 few Back Whails
 Lat obs 32-40 S
 Long obs 177-33 W

Tuesday Begins with pleasant weather
 the 7th Wind at S.W. Standing to
 343th out the S.W. Employed in Repairing
 the main top sail
 Latter part of the day Employed in
 shifting the fresh water in the
 other Casks found the head Rotten
 Lat obs 32 00 S
 Long obs 177 28 W

Wednesday through the day fresh Breeze
 the 8th from the S.W.
 344th out Sailed a ship to Sward supposed
 it to be the balance of
 N. and found Employed as in
 Day Preceding Lat obs 31-16
 Long obs 178-12 W
