July 1829
at 5 P M got the Whal long
Side at 5 P M Begin to Cut
after several tryalls the hook
taining out & and having
the 3 mate hurt by the tackle
gave it up for the Night
very bad Sea the ship lays
very bad
at 5 A M Begin to Cut
Running before the Wind
at half Past 10 I got the
head of Day Ends with a very
bad that very day

Boat out

Begins with strong Breeze
from the E S E
Employed in Cutting
at 3 P M got the Whal in
and made the head fast long
Side as it is too Rough
to work on at present
at 12 Meridian got the head all
in and made sure to the
Lat 32° 04' N
