 Standing to the S S W
 finished Drilling Employed in
 Repairing the Gyl
 my mate Sick. He land
 having sent him off in the
 Boat yesterday
 at 4 A M sailed to the S S W
 at 8 do saw a large Mail to
 Leeward at 9 Landed 2 Boats &
 killed him at 10 got him
 home before Day Dr. 28 with
 fine weather Wind N E
 Lat obs 32-3 N

Friday
 July 17th
 353 out

July 17th 1829
 Begins with fair weather
 Wind N E at 1 P M
 Begin. Cutting at half Past 3
 got the head of
 at 4 P M got all in but the
 Cais and had that made
 fast long side at 9 finished
 Drilling the Cais saw a sail
 to Leeward
