Friday July 1829
The 24 Through the day fine weather
360 out and almost Calm

Employed in stowing down
oil in the main hatch
Saw porpoises and Black porpoises
at meridian finished
Chocking of the main hatch
Day Ends with very warm
Weather

Lat obs 33-9 N

Sat The 25 Begins with fine weather
Wind at NNE Saw porpoises
360 out Employed in brackeing
out in the fore hold

to stow down oil
at 10 P.M. took in sail and
lay by under the fore sail
and main top sail
