Sighted all the Boats and
killed 2 large ones

Day ends in Lat 32-19 N

The 12th
378 out

Begins with fine weather
Wind at East
Employed in getting the
Whale's long side
at 7 P.M. got there both
long side and main
part and took in sail
Latter part employed
in cutting got one Whale
in all but the head
Lat obs 32-14 N

Thurs
The 13th
379 out

August 1829
Begins with fine weather
Wind at E.
Employed in cutting up
the other Whales head &
hauling and setting up Hooks
my mate sick he was
having got something in
his eye
Lat obs 32-24 N

Frid
The 14th
380 out

Through the day Employed
in hauling and setting up
Hooks cutting up the
junks &c
Cut in part of the
other Whale and let
the other part go
having more than I can
use
Lat obs 32-42 N
Long 179 E
