Commenced with a light breeze from NW
Showery at 6 A strong Squall from North staved
South with all sail out middle light & baffling
from SW Westward later heavy Showers light airs
from Northward at 10. Cleared 3 sail in light
A light breeze from SSW Latitude Obs 6.13.58

Friday 18th Long Obs 21.39.15

First part lively breezes from SSW to SSW middle
Strong & Squally from SW to South S. J. Sails in later
Strong breezes from South Clear Ships Head from
SE by E to ESE at 6 A Ship off Leitham on same
tack Latitude Obs 5.38 Long 20.24 W

Saturday 19th

All these 24 hours Strong breezes from South to South SE
at 6 P.M. tacked to N.E. N. Ships head from NW to S.W. N.
so ends & no whales all in good health except Mr. Burgess
& the Shipkeeper Latitude 5.24 Long at 2 P.M. 20.55

Sunday 20th

All these 24 hours lively breezes from S.E. to S.E. S.
fine weather by the wind to South westward at 6 A
A Brig off led been on same tack Latitude 4.16

Note have experienced 20 or 30 miles Long at 2 P.M. 21.36

All these 24 hours light winds from S.E. to South
fine weather by the wind to South westward
at 3 P.M. past A Barke steering to Northward later
watch employed on the rigging & varnishing the deck
Latitude Obs 3.17 Long at 10 A.M. 22.15 30

All these 24 hours lively breezes from South steered
by the wind to N.W. & S.W. Latitude Obs 2.36
Long at 10 A.M. 23.43

South to S.W. fine weather steered to East & SE
by the wind later saw Blackfish lowered could
not get fast Latitude 3.02 Long at 2 P.M. 22.16

All these First part moderate breezes from S.W. to
Ships head E.S. Middle unsteady & baffling later
fresh from South Ships head ESE Latitude 3.56

Saturday 26th Long at 10 A.M. 21.13

First part fresh breezes from South middle & later
Strong from South to S.W. Ships head from SE to ESE
Latitude Obs 3.39 Long at 10 A.M. 19.43
at 3 P.M. 19.27.15

Sunday 27th By Lunar 19.21.10

First part Strong breezes from South at 10 P.M.
tacked to N.W. middle lively from South to S.E.
later fresh from S.E. Lat 2.14 Long at 3 P.M. 19.55

Monday 28th By Rean of 3 Lun 19.43

All these 24 hours lively breezes from S.E. to SE
steered by the wind to South westward Latitude 0.54.58
Long at 3 P.M. 20.50

Tuesday 29th

All these 24 hours lively breezes from South to SE
fine weather steered by the wind to S.W. & N.W.
at 6 A.M. past A Ship steering to NW Latitude 00.43.8

Wednesday 30th Longitude at 10 A.M. 21.36

Long at 10 A.M. 22.40.30 Latitude 3.30.8
