

Remarks On Board Bark Roscoe

Sunday November 15th 1846

All these 24 hours Moderate Breezes from North to NNE Middle Rainy At 1 P.M. Saw a whale turn pale later under all Sail on Diff. Tacks But no whales green water & a Plenty Birds Latitude 35.55

Monday 16th Long. At Merid 32.12

Commences fine Breezes from North fine weather under all Sail At 1 P.M. Steered SW. in 5. Set in thick & rainy Middle & later thick rainy dirty weather light Breezes from North westward headed to NW. Later Small Breezes & Calm Steered East the water green & but a few Birds Lat. 36.35 Long 33.00 At

Tuesday 17th

First part lively Breezes from North to NW Steered by the wind to North Eastward wet & rainy the most of the time No whales to be seen Middle Small Breezes from NW to SW later lively Breezes from South fine clear weather Steered NE under all Sail Saw one finback Note all the Sick Men have got about Latitude 35.34 Long Merid 31.28 Chro

Wednesday 18th

First part fine Breezes from SE to ESE fine pleasant weather Middle Steered NE Middle light & bawling under Double reefs to North & NNE later Brisk breezes from NNE Steered NW No Whales have in Light but 1 Sulphur Bottom the water blue all these 24 hours a few of the Small Species of Whale Birds in Light goneys scarce Latitude 34.34 Long Long. At Noon.

Thursday 19th

First part lively breezes from NNE clear weather Steered NW At 4 P.M. filled fifty bbls of water to heat the Ship so as to melt on the Copper that is started off the Starboard Side Middle on diff. Tacks later Strong Breezes from NNE to NE flying Clouds Saw finbacks & a quantity whale fade Steered to NNE by the wind At 10 Double reefed Latitude Obs 33.56

Friday 20th Long. At Merid 22.55 W

First part fresh breezes from North flying Clouds by the wind to NNE under Double & Single reefs Middle & later fresh gales & rainy on Diff. Tacks under Short Sail No Observation

Lat 32 33.45 Long 23.25

Cruising in the South Atlantic Ocean

Saturday November 21st 1846

First & Middle fresh breezes from North to NNE thick rainy on diff. Tacks later lively from SE Steered NE Cloudy & Drizzle a high Swell from NNE Saw finbacks & whale fade No Observation Lat. 33.40 Long. At 22.40

Sunday 22nd

All these 24 hours Moderate unsleddy breezes from NNE to ENE very foggy & dirty weather on Diff. Tacks a good many goneys but no whales & No Observations Lat. At 33.30 Long. At 22.30

Monday 23rd

First & Middle light breezes from North to NE thick Rainy & foggy on diff. Tacks later Moderate from ENE fine weather Steered to North under all Sail at 10. Tacked to SE Saw finbacks Latitude 33.24 Long at Noon 23.35

Tuesday 24th

All these 24 hours lively breezes from ENE First & later fair Steered to Eastward by the wind under all Sail Middle to North under Double reefs So Ends Another 24 hours & no whales Latitude Obs 33.30 Long. At Noon 23.18

Wednesday 25th

First part fresh breezes from NNE Steered to SE NE under all Sail At 7 tacked Ship to SSE Stead whole watches At 12 tacked to ESE later Moderate from NNE under all Sail to East & ESE Drizzle & Overcast not a whale to be seen Latitude Obs 34.10 Long. At 4 P.M. Chro 22.05.30

Thursday 26th

Lunar 10

21.52.45

All these 24 hours Moderate Breezes from NNE fine pleasant weather Steered to Eastward by the wind Middle under Double reefs At Sunset Saw whale fade later Some 12 or 15 finbacks & fade but no Mr. Whales Latitude — 34.04

Long At 4 P.M. Chro 20.53

Friday 27th

By Lunar 10

20.41

All these 24 hours light pleasant weather wind NNE to North Steered to East first part Saw finbacks later nothing repaired At Sail. & At Sail Latitude Obs 34.10

Long. At 4 Chro 19.26.00
