

Remarks On Board Bark Rescue

Wednesday August 25th 1847

All these 24 hours Light breezes from E & E fine
Clear weather Steered to South Eastward by the wind
under all Sail At 3 PM finished & bent mainsail
Later Emp breaking out for water Cask & drinking
A lot of small cast ready for eating & C
Lat Obs 25 38 Long At 3 PM 43 56

Thursday 26th

All these 24 hours Small breezes from ENE to NE fine
Clear weather Steered by the wind to South Eastward
watch Emp in various galls breaking out fore hole
for Pipe Shocks to get up for water & towing off overhaul
& raising about to make room & C Later Cooper getting
up Pipe Shocks Latitude Obs 25 45 Long At 3 PM 43 08

Friday 27th

Commenced Calm At 5 PM A small breeze from
NNW Steered NE Middle lively breezes from NNW to
West later Moderate from West to N.W. watch Emp
in various galls Latitude 24 33 Long At 2 30 42 54

Saturday 28th

First Part lively breezes from WSW fine with
A high swell from SW Steered ESE in hopes to
sight the Land before Dark but did not At 8
Steered N.W. with A smart breeze At 11 nearly Calm
from 12 till 6 AM nearly Calm with A high swell
Small breezes during the remainder of the Day from N.W. & W
Steered N.W. & W. Vary smart Lat 24 13 Long 43 13
have experienced 15 miles Southerly Current

Sunday 29th

First Part Moderate breezes from WSW fine
weather Steered ESE At 5 30 the Land 10 miles off
then Steered N.W. the till 10 run the list of 22 miles
back inn light Sails heighd off & on At 12
nearly Calm Later small airs from South Steered
East & E N.W. the Land in sight Saw A small
Schooner off Shore Borend Southward Lat 23 57

Monday 30th

All these 24 hours Light Moderate weather
first Part from WSW At Sunset up with Land
Land At 6 30 were ship & started out by the
wind it being to Dark to Proceed to the anchorage
middle heighd off & on During the Night wind from WSW
to SSE At 10 A lively sea breeze came inn At 12 30 came
to anchor in 7 fath water & layed away 15 fath Chances

Leighing At Ancha inn St. Augustus Bay

Tuesday August 31st

First Part fresh sea breezes Middle Calm
Later Light Land fine clear weather
A Number of the Big Min Maid their Appearance

Wednesday Sept 1st

All this Day fine weather light winds first
Part got off A raft of water Later stowed
it away Prince Will came on board with
his governors & Passers to Spoke the Surveys

Thursday 2nd

First Part lively Sea breezes Start watch on
Shore on Liberty got A Bullock for A Musket
that weighed 300 lbs Later & Boated off 3 Loads of
Wood & C fine weather

Friday 3rd

First Part Strong sea breezes One watch on Shore
on Liberty the other on Emp on board Middle Moderate
Later got off A raft of water & got 2 Loads of Wood
out of the River One Boat filled but side of the Point
& Lost some of the wood & got off with one half of
A Load Long by Chas 44 43 44

Saturday 4th

First Part Strong sea breezes from West to SW
Clear weather All hands on board Emp Stowing
Lawn Water & Wood Middle Moderate Later lively
Land breeze A Considerable swell leaving inn took
off 2 small Loads of Wood from the Point At Watch
on Liberty Long At 3 PM Chas 43 37

Sunday 5th

First Part Fresh breezes from West to SW
Start watch on liberty got one small Bullock
Later fresh Land breezes At 10 30 sea breeze set
inn

Monday 6th

All this Day Moderate weather first 20 miles
swell Later got A raft of water & 1 Load
of Wood

Note the Chas gives the Long of the Arch
By Adding 5 miles the same As when I
Left Sofala Bay
