A light breeze sprung up from North Steered S.W. later A light breeze from East Steered S.W. with Studding sails Set At 4 P.M. finished Boiling Note: Last Exp 20th C. current Lat Obs 13.03 Long At 3 P.M. 47.04

Sunday 10th

Commences with light airs from ENE At 2 Calm At 8 P.M. A lively breeze from NW clear & fine pleasant weather Steered NW & later S.W. later S.W. from NW to West by the wind to South Westward

Lat Obs 14.06 Long At 4 P.M. 46.20

Monday 11th

All these 24 hours light breezes from NW to N.W. & Calm first Part Steered to South Westward later to North West later all hands Emp Coopering & Stowing down Oil Between decks Aft. Lat Obs 14.31 Long At Merid 45.35

Thursday 14th

First part light airs from the Southward & Calm At 5 P.M. Came to Anchor in 8 fathoms water Middle & later Small breezes from the land & Calm So ends Part watch on liberty Start Emp in Ships Duty Cooper Getting up Hooks for water Blacksmith making Reels

All these 24 hours light & fine weather Watch on liberty Start Emp in Ships Duty

Saturday Sept 16th

Wednesday 20th

First part lively breezes from ENE middle Calm later fine from East flying Clouds got off 2 Bullock 1 Raft of Mate 30 bbls which fills all of my Cask & makes 125 bbls on Board

Thursday 21th

First Part lively breeze from ENE fine weather middle Calm first part got All ready for sea later a fine breeze from ENE At 8 A.M. got under way & stood out of the Bay to the North West

Note By taking 4 minutes & 16 seconds from the Chron Note the gives the Long 44.24 the same as the Chart I have also reduced the Log by Note 1/4 which leaves 3rd Log

Friday 22th

First Part Small breezes from NE Steered to South At 1 P.M. Saddle Island bore 98 first 6 miles middle Calm & strong 92 At 5 A.M. A light breeze sprung up from South Steered to Westward by the wind under full sail Killed a Bullock Saturday 23th

First Part Small breezes from Southward Steered to Westward Saw Lump Backs going quick to South Eastward middle Calm later Small airs from S.W. to S. by the wind to South Westward Lat Obs 12.48 Long 3 P.M. Chron 44.16

Sunday 24th

First Part Small airs from SE middle from S.W. Steered S.W. later light breeze from NE Steered to SE by the wind to S.W. is lively with Porpoises grasshoppers & C. but No Whales make their Lat Obs 13.26 Long 3 P.M. 44.25 Appearance
