

Remark On Board of Bark Roscoe

Monday Sept 25th 1848

All these 24 hours Calms & light Breezes from Northward clear & very hot weather headed to North Westward later watch Emp in various gals making fore topmast standing Shil Booms & at Lower Studingsail Blacksmithing &c Lat Obs 13.15 Long 41.20

Tuesday 26th

First & Middle of these 24 hours Small airs & calm later lively from SSE Steered NW to Ends & No Whales Watch Emp in Ships Duty Lat Obs 13.38 Long 41.29

Wednesday 27th

These 24 hours light Breezes & Calms first part Steered to NNE at 5.30 tacked to South Saw a Bala to Eastward called her the Ego of Hobland Bound to Johanna from Bally Bay Middle Calm later light from South & SSE Lat Obs 13.44 Long 41.29

Thursday 28th

All these 24 hours light Breezes from Southward Northward & Southeastward & Calm Steered to SSW & to NNE Watch Emp in Ships Duty Uplite Spanker Boom Lat 14.23 Long 43.38

Friday 29th

First Part Moderate Breezes from the Eastward Steered SSW at 5 P.M. Set fore top & main top galin Studingsails Middle Small airs from North East & North Westward & Calm later Moderate from SE to SE clear & fine weather Lat Obs 15.29 Long 44.44

Saturday 30th

First Part light Breezes from ENE Steered NNE at 4 called to North & called gradually round to West at 10 tacked to NNE Middle & later fresh from SSE at 8 AM tacked Ship to SE Lat Obs 15.30 Long 43.18

Sunday Oct 1st 1848

First & Middle of these 24 hours Fresh Breezes from SE to SSW at 6 P.M. tacked Ship to West Middle Single reef the topsails at 2 AM tacked to SE later Mac Moderate Ends light all sail Set Lat Obs 15.40 Long 43.10

Monday 2nd

First & Middle light breezes from South to SSW Steered to Westward by the wind later from SE to SE watch Emp in Ships duty Lat Obs 16.10 Long 42.15

From Johanna Towards Europa Island &c

Tuesday November October 3rd 1848

First & Middle of these 24 hours Calms later Small Breezes from East Steered SSW under all sail Studingsails No & Mast fore & main topmast Studingsails Set watch Emp in Ships Duty Latitude 16.34 Long 42.08

Wednesday 4th

First Part About Calm Middle Small breezes from SSW Steered to SSW later Moderate from SE to East at 10 AM Set Studingsails & Stead SSW Watch Emp in Ships Duty Lat Obs 16.51 Long 41.45

Thursday 5th

Commences with a Small breeze from SE at 4 P.M. Calm at 8 & Small breeze from South Middle from SE later light from SE to East clear & fine All sail Set Stead SSW Lat 17.32 Long 42.53

Friday 6th

All these 24 hours lively breezes from East to SE fine weather Steered South under All sail Lat Obs 19.00 Long 42.30 P.M. 41.36

Saturday 7th

All these 24 hours Small airs from North round to Westward & SSW & Calms Steered by the wind to South Eastward Ends Small airs from North Lat 18.48

Sunday 8th

First & Middle fine Breezes the most of the time from NW to NNE Steered SSW & South later Calm & light airs from Northward Lat Obs 18.51 Long 42.27

Monday 9th

First Part Small breezes from North & N Westward Steered to SSW Middle the wind from SE to SSW at 3 AM tacked Ship to SSW later fresh breezes from SSW ships head NNE Lat Obs 19.09 Long 41.57

Tuesday 10th

First Part fresh breezes from SSW to SSW Steered to Westward by the wind Middle Strong from South kept the topsails the sea rough later the same miles N. Count Lat Obs 19.13 Long 41.45

Wednesday 11th

First & Middle of these 24 hours Strong breezes from SSW to SE at 4 P.M. tacked Ship to SE under Single reef later Moderate Lat Exp 30 Miles North Count Lat Obs 19.10 Long 41.50
