Remarks On Board of the Bark
Thursday November 16th 1848

These 24 hours lively & moderate breezes from
NNW to NNE on diff tacks had up some 20
or 30 miles NNE current Lat Obs 35.32

Friday 17th Long 80.16.22.00

First Part lively Breezes from NNE fine
weather started to S.W. at 7 tacked to NNE middle
fresh from NNE at 7 tacked to S.W. Wind from
NNW to NNE 3 sail in light toeward at 11 took
down 1 top galsail Latitude Obs 36.03 S
Long at 9.16.21.10 E

Saturday 18th

First & middle of these 24 hours strong
breezes from NNE to NNE flying clouds
at 6.30 P.M. tacked ship to NNE under bare top
sails ship's head during the night from NNE to
NW later light breezes from SW to SSE set
all standing sails main royal sent out 1/2 gill boom
& set the sail Lat Obs 35.58 Long 80.20.21

Sunday 19th Lunar 19.57

First Part lively Breezes from SE fine
weather course NW standing sails set at 6 & aloft
on both sides & main royal middle strong
at 4 A.M. steered NNE lively Breezes during the
day Lat Obs 35.06 Long Merid 17.53 East

Monday 20th

First & middle of these 24 hours strong breezes
from SSE to South flying clouds & overcasts
saw 4 or 5 sail all bound the same way course
NNW Lat Obs 33.32 Long Merid 15.46

Tuesday 21st

All these 24 hours strong breezes from SSE
to South mostly cloudy. Steered NNE under all
sail watch crew in various gobs Lat Obs 31.57
Long Merid 13.19

Wednesday 22nd

All these 24 hours strong & fresh breezes
from South course NNE
Latitude 30.47
Long at Merid 11.18

Roscoe of New Bedford from Rosambique
Thursday November 23rd 1848

All these 24 hours fresh breezes from South to SSE
& fair at 1 P.M. A brig past ahead 3 miles
Dist by the wind to the westward course
NNW under all sail Lat Obs 28.51 Long Merid 9.18

Friday 24th

First Part lively Breezes from South middle
strong later moderate 3 sail in sight 10 off
each squaler during the same 30 ends, the
watch crew turning out & in the main
rigging Lat Obs 27.35 Long Merid 7.30

Saturday 25th

All these 24 hours fine trades from South
to SSE mostly overcast watch crew in ship
July On the lower rigging Lat Obs 26.10

Sunday 26th Long 5.40

These 24 hours the wind has been from South to SSE
mostly cloudy middle & later light drizzly rain
at intervals the breeze unsteady but lively the most
of the time Latitude Obs 24.52 Long S.D.M. 4.9 E

Monday 27th

The most of these 24 hours fine breezes from
South to SSE but unsteady middle light rain
at intervals later all hands crew in washing
iron side of the ship course NNE Lat Obs 23.59

Tuesday 28th

All these 24 hours moderate weather wind SSE
first Part all hands crew cleaning the iron side
of the ship & various other gobs late watch
to work on the rigging Lat. Feb 22.30

Wednesday 29th

All these 24 hours moderate trades from SSE to SE mostly
overcast. first Part watch crew on the rigging later
later washing out side of the ship Lat Obs 21.33

Thursday 30th

All these 24 hours moderate trade winds & mostly
overcast first part the watch crew in washing
& painting the iron work out side of the ship
later on the rigging Latitude Obs 20.32 South
Long at Merid 1.19 West
