 When the Moons Limb diameter & Horizontal Parallax of the
 is the greatest ~~the Moon~~ She is then in that part of her Orbit
 nearest the Earth call'd the Perigee & the Apogee is when the
 Limb diameter & Horizontal Parallax is the least the Moon
 being then at her greatest Distance from the Earth

The perigee of the Moon is likely to be accompanied with
 the greatest Change which hapen from a single Lunar
 Point.

The New Moon next to the Perigee is likely to be accomp-
 anied by the greatest Changes of Weather

A New Moon coinciding with the Perigee the greatest
 Changes may be Expected viz 33 to 1 that a Change hapens

New Moon coinciding with the Apogee 1 to 1 that a Change
 hapens

Full Moon coinciding with the Perigee 1 to 1 that a Change hapens

Full Moon coinciding with the Apogee 5 to 1 that a Change hapens

If New Moon & Perigee coincide when the Sun is on the
 Equator the Chance of a Change of Weather must be great
