Middle Part strong gales took in the main
topmast sail at 4 AM set the main top-
mast sail latter part strong gales and
squally So ends Lat by obs 33° 15 Long 14° 23

Tuesday Sept the 21
Three 24 hours came with strong gales from
the S.W. and squally ship under all sail at 4 PM
took in the topmast at 5 PM squ-
ally with light breeze Middle Part fresh breeze
at 10 AM set the fore topmast sail let the reef
out the fore topmast latter part light breeze
So ends Lat by obs 32° 53 S

the S.E. and cloudy ship under all sail by
