Sunday Oct the 24  
These 24 hours comm with fine breeze from  
the S.W. and hazy weather. Ship under  
all sail. Morning S.E. wind employed on  
Ship's duty at 4 P.M. Breeze out for water.  
Middle part fine breeze and hazy weather stands  
with light fair. Latter part thick weather  
So ends this day 30th

Monday Oct the 25  
These 24 hours commences with fine breeze  
from the North and thick hazy weather.  
Ship under all sail. Morning S.E. at 3 P.M. fine  
The main sail. Middle part Irish breeze at 8 A.M.  
Saw fine back whale. Latter part Irish breeze and  
hazy. Lat by obs 33° 05' S Long 89° 55' East

Tuesday Oct the 26  
These 24 hours comm with Irish breeze and passing  
clouds. Ship under all sail. Morning S.E. wind  
at North was employed on Ship's duty. Middle  
part Irish breeze at 7 P.M. Dull. Next the topsails  
at 9 A.M. hazy in the main sail. Latter part strong  
gale from the North. So ends this day

Wednesday Oct the 27  
These 24 hours comm with strong gale. From the  
North and heavy at 2 P.M. wind holds to the  
South. Middle part Irish gales. Dull. Next the  
topsails. Next the topsails. Latter part Irish gales and fine weather. Set the  
gill and main sail. So ends  
Lat by obs 35° 05' S Long 86° 38' East

Thursday Oct the 28<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours comm with Irish gales from  
the South. Ship under Dull. Next the topsails  
Strong East. Middle part fine breeze at 4:30  
A.M. Set the topsails at 5 A.M. Set the  
main. Topsails. Latter part Irish gales and  
passing clouds. Lat by obs 33° 55' S Long 89° 55' East

Friday Oct the 29<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours comm with Irish  
from the S.E. Ship under all sail. Strong East  
on the wind was employed on Ship's duty.  
Breeze out the after hole. Next the middle part  
Irish gales at 8 A.M. saw fine back whale. Latter  
part Irish gales and cloudy weather. So ends these  
24 hours. Lat by account 33° 16' S Long 91° 30' E

Saturday Oct the 30<sup>th</sup>  
These 24 hours comm with Irish gales from the  
S.E. and cloudy weather. Ship under all sail  
by the wind to the Eastward at 3 P.M. saw four  
Whales going past to the S.E. board three  
boats and chased at 4 P.M. came on board  
at 4 P.M. Shorter sail. More the light at one  
P.M. wore ship to the westward at 6 A.M. under  
all sail. Strong S.E. Latter part Irish breeze. So ends  
Lat by obs 33° 11' South

Sunday Oct the 31<sup>st</sup>  
These 24 hours comm with  
Irish breeze from the S.W. Ship under all sail  
by the wind to the S.E. was employed on  
Ship's duty at 4 P.M. on board the topsails  
and set another. Middle part fine breeze at 5 A.M.  
saw four light whales. board 4 boats and chased but  
could not get past. So ends. Lat by obs 33° 27' S Long 94° 30' E
