 breeze from the N.E. and fairing all
 hands employed on boiling and
 cupping three fore sail in sight
 at 5 AM sail set to the S.W.
 at 7 AM wind shifted and then to the S.E.
 at 9 AM wind backing Suble Night
 Lat 42° 30' 00" The topsails latter part Irish wind from
 Long 126° 15' E The rest working in sight

Wednesday Jan 25 These 24 hours commences with Irish
 gale from the N.E. and hazy ship
 ship under Suble Night topsails strong
 with all hands employed on boiling
 and cupping three at 6 PM saw whale
 board three boats and chist with out
 success at 5 PM took in sail for the
 Night Middle part fair weather at
 8 PM took up haul from the west
 at 7 AM began showing some
 Lat 42° 30' 00" latter part heavy gale from the
 Long 126° 45' W. Drifted to leeward fifty barrels
 of oil to ender this day, finish day
 long

 gale from the westward ship lying
 fore under her three spinnies and
 fore spinnies stay sail heading S.W.
 with the Coast Huf main topsail
 set at 5 PM set least that main
 topsail Middle part heavy gale from
 the westward at 6 PM set the fore sail
 Lat 42° 30' 00" at 9 PM set Suble Night topsails latter
 Long 125° 45' Part ends with Irish gale and hazy

Friday Jan 27 These 24 hours comm with Irish gale
 from the N.E. and heavy sea on
 ship under Suble Night topsails head
 ing to the South at 5 PM took in sail
 fore the right Middle part Irish gale
 at 5 AM began showing some
 at 11 PM set showing to ender this day

Saturday Jan 28 These 24 hours comm with a
 light breeze from the westward
 and fair weather at one PM set
 Suble Night fore and main and brize
 topsail were ship to the North at 3 PM
 set the main sail full at 4 PM
 took in sail for the right Middle
 part heavy gale at 7 PM were ship
 Lat 42° 30' 00" to the S.W. latter part ends with heavy
 Long 126° 30' gale from the westward and heavy sea

Sunday Jan 29 These 24 hours comm with a heavy gale
 from the westward ship lying fore
 under Coast Huf main topsails and
 fore and main spinnies fore spinnies
