Jan the 24
Hoveena of Palmer 1843
These 24 hours come with fine
breeze from the NW and fine
weather ship under all sail steering
East for New Zealand Middle part Irish
breeze at 8 AM Tuck in the main top
& gale sail at 9 AM Sable Tuck
Lat By 46° 26' N Long 153° 20' W
The topsails latter part Irish gales and
hazy weather to end

Tuesday
Jan the 25
These 24 hours come with Irish
gales from the South and thick hazy
weather ship under double Tuck
topsails steering E by S at 8 PM Tuck in
the gill and main sail clearest Tuck
the Mizzen topsail at 4 PM Tuck in
the Bow Boat at 10 PM clearest Tuck
The fore topsails Middle part Irish gales
at 4 AM main all sail Tuck East at 9
AM Tacking with light squalls of wind
Tuck in the main topsails sail later
Lat By 47° 06' N Long 155° 40' E
Part Master set the main topsails
to end

Wednesday
Jan the 26
These 24 hours come with fine breeze
from the NW and fine weather
ship under all sail steering E by S
Tack Employed on ship's duty sailing
in light Middle part light breeze
at 3 AM began morning sail at 10
AM Calm with a heavy swell from
the Westward at 11 AM
Tack ship to the S E later part
Calm with light breeze and calm
Lat By 46° 57' N Long 157° 08'

For New Zealand. Clark Estes Master
Thursday
Jan the 27
The first Part of these 24 hours began
with light breeze from the E by S
and hazy weather ship under all sail
by the wind ship head S E with
heavy swell from the Westward
Middle part light breeze from the
Lat By 46° 22' N Long 157° 12' E
later part continued the same

Friday
Jan the 28
These 24 hours come with light
breeze from the S E and hazy weather
ship under all sail by the wind
to the E by S at 4 PM wind evening
at 8 PM Tuck in the fore topsails
sail at 10 PM Sable Tuck the topsails
Tuck in the gill and main sail latter
part Irish gales and hazy weather
at 8 AM set the gill and main sail
at 11 AM Tuck out the topsails
Lat By 46° 07' N Long 156° 40' E
later part ends with Irish gales from
the S E to end these 24 hours

Saturday
Jan the 29
These 24 hours come with fresh
breeze from the S E and fine weather
ship under all topsails sail at 8
PM Tuck out the main topsails
at 4 PM set the main topsails
sail ship head East Middle part
light breeze and fine weather at 5 AM
Tuck out the main topsails
Lat By 46° 10' N Long 155° 24' E
later part light breeze and hazy
weather to end
