

Ship Movement of Fallowier 1842
 Tuesday
 March the 20 These 24 hours commencing with a brisk
 Gale from the Westward ship lying low
 under the three Fore and aft sails head
 ing to the S.W. at 2 P.M. the Fore sail
 and Suble Reef Fore and Main Topsail
 and Head of S.C. Black Smith the St. of
 Sails and one or two more Enrolled.
 Middle part light breeze and hazy sea
 from the S.E. at 5 A.M. made sail at 8
 A.M. saw whale at 7 A.M. heard two whistles
 Chased with cut sails at 9 A.M. boat
 then Boat's Boat Boat struck and cut
 Bow Boat gut stove at 10.30 Tuck the
 whale to the ship and began cutting
 Longin 176.00 Later part Ende with light breeze and hazy
 Monday
 March the 21 These 24 hours commencing with a light breeze from
 the S.W. and hazy weather at 8 P.M.
 finished cutting main sail at 6 P.M.
 Tuck in sail and set the wash Hoyleing
 ship head to the Eastward Middle part
 light breeze at 6 A.M. set Suble Reef Topsail
 at 8 A.M. Hazy later part continued
 The same to Ende
 Tuesday
 March the 22 These 24 hours commencing with a brisk breeze
 from the South and thick Hazy weather
 at one P.M. Tuck in sail and could
 come at 5 P.M. but up Haining Middle
 part Haining at 5 A.M. Hazy at 7 A.M. began
 Hoyleing at 10 A.M. let the Haps out the main
 Topsail later part light breeze and thick Hazy
 Weather to Ende
 Wednesday
 March the 23 These 24 hours commencing with a light breeze from
 the S.W. and thick weather all
 the wash employed on Hoyleing at one
 P.M. set the Fore and Main Topsail and
 Gills at 5 P.M. finished Hoyleing at 6
 P.M. Tuck in sail the light side
 to the Westward at 8 P.M. hazy signals from
 the South Tuck in Fore Sail and Main
 Topsail at 8 A.M. hazy gale at 6 A.M. more
 Left Haps 146.51 Midnat began Hoyleing down at 11 A.M. fine
 Longin 177.16 later part Hazy weather to Ende
 Thursday
 March the 24 These 24 hours commencing with a fresh gale from
 the S.W. at one P.M. set the Fore sail
 and Suble Reef Topsails ship head E.S.E.
 wash employed on Hoyleing down at 4 P.M.
 bent the Fore sail at 6 P.M. Tuck in sail
 Middle part light breeze from the S.W. at 8 A.M.
 made sail at 8 A.M. saw whale heard 2 Barks
 Left Haps 146.51 and Chast with cut Lucies later part
 Longin 177.35 Hazy wind from the S.W. to Ende
 Friday
 March the 25 These 24 hours commencing with a brisk breeze
 from the S.W. and hazy weather ship
 under all sail Hoyleing S.W. saw several
 Humpbacks at 2 P.M. Suble Reef the Fore
 Topsail saw a ship to the South at 5 P.M.
 spoke the ship Tyler of Stonington with two
 Barks of oil at 6 P.M. Tuck in sail fore
 the light side were ship to the Westward
 Middle part hazy gale from the S.W. at
 at 6 P.M. were ship to the S.W. and West
 Left Haps 146.51 saw sail later part hazy gale and Hoyleing
 Longin 178.25 Closure to Ende
