

Ship *Peewee* of Fall River 1852
Friday
April the 1st These 24 hours came with a heavy gale
from the NW and thick weather
Ship lying under three spans at 3 PM
The wind shifted in a gale from NW to
SE and in the forenoon at 6 PM
Went ship to the North Middle part bay
Left by 10 AM at 2 PM was ship later part
Longitude 17° 15' the same to end

Saturday
April the 2nd These 24 hours came with thick gale
from the south ship lying under two
spans ship head SE all hands
employed in stowing down at 3 PM
Set the fore sail and abast reef main
sails at 5 PM were in order at 6 PM
To the SE Middle part Irish breeze and
fine weather at 6 PM made sail at 7
AM saw whale boat two boats and chas
No ch this day With out success one ship in sight
later part light breeze and foggy weather

Sunday
April the 3rd These 24 hours came with a light
breeze from the NW and thick foggy
weather ship under all sail by the
wind at 2 PM saw whale boat two boats
and chas with out success at 3 PM
Tuck in the main sail and main
topgallant sail at 6 PM shortened sail
to the right wind SE and saw sail ahead
Middle part light breeze at 6 AM made
sail at 7 AM saw whale boat and
chas with out success at 10 AM heard
No ch this day and chas with out success later part
Irish breeze & ships in sight

On New Zealand Clark Estes master
Monday
April the 4th These 24 hours came with a light
breeze from the south ship under
single reef topsails on the wind
to the SE at one PM saw whale boat
two boats and chas boat went on
boat the first at 6 PM shortened
sail to the right Middle part
light breeze at 6 AM made sail at 7 AM
saw whale boat two boats and chas
With out success later part light breeze
and cloudy weather to end

Tuesday
April the 5th These 24 hours came with light breeze
from the south ship under all
sail at one PM saw whale boat
two boats and chas with out success
at 2 PM finished laying at 3 PM spoke
the Irish ship same not seen but
later went on board at 6 PM tuck in
sail for the right Middle part light
breeze at 6 AM made sail and heard
No ch this day in company with fore sail
later part Irish breeze to end

Wednesday
April the 6th These 24 hours came with Irish wind
from the south ship under all sail
striking south at one PM saw whale
boat two boats and chas with out
success at 3 PM heard two boats with
out success at 4 PM heard two boats
with out success & ships in sight at 6
PM tuck in sail to the right Middle
part Irish breeze from the SE at 6 AM
made sail later part saw whale boat and chas
with out success to end
