Middle part fine breeze and fine weather at 6 PM were the land at 9 PM came to anchor in whet Bay at the Chatham Island with the small bow anchor with 30 fathoms of chain cut. Saturday
 April the 23 These 24 hours came with slight breeze from the S.W. and fine weather set lying in the Bay at one PM sent one boat of cash and show for water. Middle part light breeze from the S.W. and Hauling at 7 PM set the Standard which goes show on liberty all the work on board employed in hauling out and stowing some water at 9 PM the chain to the small anchor. Under the land and let go the West Tower and brought her up later part light breeze from the S.E. to Ende

Sunday
 April the 24 These 24 hours came with light breeze and calm at PM were ship to the Bay have up the West Tower anchor and hold up to the small anchor and let go the West Tower. Under the bow rope in the horse boat in order to weigh the anchor the rope parted and lost the anchor at 4 PM on bent the fore top sail and went on deck one
