Wednesday
July the 3^d These 24 hours came with a fine
Breeze from the South and fine
Weather Ship under all sail Steering
East all the watch employed on
Ships Duty Middle part fine breeze
Lat By obs 24.09 At 10 AM light shores of Maine
Long in 150.45 So ends these 24 hours

Thursday
July the 4th These 24 hours came with a fine
Breeze from the West and passing
clouds Ship under all sail Steering
East all the watch employed on
Siding the ship at 5 PM Break
the ship ahead of Greenport with 1000
Middle part light breeze Cap compassing
with the ship at 10 AM Capitan
Lat By obs 23.01 Case came on board later part fine
Long in 150.48 Weather So ends

Monday
July the 5th These 24 hours came with a slight
Wind from the South and pleasant
Weather Ship under all sail Steering
to the North at 9 PM how
back Middle part light breeze at 6
Lat By obs 21.00 AM Squared away and made sail
Long in 150.47 later part fine Breeze So ends

Tuesday
July the 6th These 24 hours came with a fine
Breeze from the S.E. and fine weather
Ship under all sail Steering to the North
in company with the Ship (name of)
Greenport at 6 PM Shorten sail
Lat By obs 20.00 Took the light at 6 AM made sail
Long in 150.46 Steered North later part fine Breeze

Ship *Estes Master* 1853.

Wednesday
July the 6th These 24 hours came with a fine
Breeze from the S.E. and fine
Weather Ship under all sail
Squaring Steering to the North all
the watch employed on Ships
Duty Steered in company with
the Briade at 5 PM Shorten sail
Middle part light Breeze at 6 AM
Lat By obs 19.54 Made sail and were ship to the S.E.
Long in 149.45 later part ends with light breeze

Thursday
July the 7th These 24 hours came with a slight
Breeze from the S.E. and Pleasant
Weather Ship under all sail by
the wind watch employed on
Ships Duty at 5 PM Shorten sail
Took the light Middle part light
Lat By obs 19.56 at 6 AM Made all sail later part
Long in 149.48 ends with Breeze from the North

Friday
July the 8th These 24 hours came with a slight
Breeze from the North and fine
Weather Ship under all sail
by the wind to the Eastward
Watch employed on Ships Duty
at 9 PM Cabin with shores of Maine
Middle part light breeze from the
Lat By obs 19.06 S. E. at 6 AM Made all sail
Long in 149.57 later part ends with light Breeze

Saturday
July the 9th These 24 hours came with a slight
Breeze from the E.S.E. and fine weather
Ship under all sail Steering S.W. E.
Lat By obs 18.00 Middle part light breeze at 6 AM the island
of St. John's bearing S.E. 40 Dist 30 miles
