Tuesday
July the 19 These 24 hours comm. with a fine breeze
from the E. & W. and we were on
liberty the other employed on
Painting the Ship so ended this day

Wednesday
July the 20 These 24 hours comm. with a light
breeze from the S.E. and fair weather
still being in port one watch on
liberty the other employed on
Painting the Ship Charles Carpenter
and Robert Winter Runaway & ends

Thursday
July the 21 These 24 hours comm. with a light breeze
from the S.E. and fair weather still
being in port one watch on liberty
the other employed on Painting
the Ship the Capt. S. H. on Shore

Friday
July the 22 These 24 hours comm. with a light breeze
from the S.E. with light showers
of rain at 4 P.M. the Ship when
Michael came in 9 minutes out with
a fair wind at 10 P.M. the men
went on shore with out liberty
at 1 P.M. Rogers came on board again at
3 P.M. the Ship Runaway & ends

Saturday
July the 23 These 24 hours comm. with a light breeze
from the E. & W. and cloudy weather
one watch on liberty and the other
employed on Painting the Ship so ends

Sunday
July the 24 These 24 hours comm. with a fine breeze
from the North and fair weather
still being in port later part fine weather

Monday
July the 25 These 24 hours comm. with a fine breeze
from the North and fair weather
still being in port at 9 A.M. the men
went on shore with out liberty
at 1 P.M. Rogers came on board again at
3 P.M. the Ship Runaway & ends

Tuesday
July the 26 These 24 hours comm. with a light
breeze from the Eastward still being
in port William Ester still absent
and four other men the Remainder
employed on Ship duty out of a
raft of water and the sails at 3 P.M.
Rogers went on shore with out liberty
at 1 P.M. Rogers came on board again at
3 P.M. the Ship Runaway & ends

Wednesday
July the 27 These 24 hours comm. with a light
breeze from the E. & W. at 6 A.M. Capt
Ester Shift & men are by the men
of Boston Ensign George Lacey Charles Halsey
John Ward at 9 A.M. Pilot came on
board made sail and went out and
the Ship discharged the Pilot and of and
on Capt Ester went on shore again
all the hands employed in stowing
the anchors and chains in company
with three Ships by order of the
Heads of the Harbor of New York
at 4 P.M. Capt Ester came on board with
John Tyler and Astor and one man by the
Name of John Hastings and man by the
Name of James Price did not come on
board
