

Ship *Flower of Talriver* 1842
 Thursday August the 11 These 24 hours came with a light breeze from the S.W. and cloudy weather ship under all sail. Tappan watch employed on ship duty at 4 P.M. wind shifted in a gale of rain to the South. Took in gill and main sail ship steering West at 7 P.M. stood to S.W. Middle part fine breeze at 8 AM. Let the main sail at 9 AM. Let the hook out the fore main top. Long 165.53 sail later under with fine weather.
 Friday August the 12 These 24 hours came with a fine breeze from the S.W. and fine weather ship under all sail. Tappan on the wind to the westward. Watch employed on ship duty at 4 P.M. ship head to S.W. Middle part fine breeze at 8 AM. on board the main topgallant sail and went a little later part under. Long 165.26 with a fine breeze and pleasant.
 Saturday August the 13 These 24 hours came with a light breeze from the South and fine weather ship under all sail. Steering S.W. watch employed on ship duty at 6 P.M. stood S.W. Middle part fine breeze and pleasant weather.
 Long 166.42 later part continued the same so comes.

Ship *Estes Master* 1842
 Sunday August the 14 These 24 hours came with a light breeze from the Eastward and fine weather ship under all sail. Steering S.W. watch employed on ship duty. Middle part light breeze at 5 AM. wind held to the S.W. Let the fore and main topgallant sail later part pleasant.
 Monday August the 15 These 24 hours came with a light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather ship under all sail. Steering to S.W. Middle part light breeze and variable later part cleared. Long 169.16 S.W. to comes.
 Tuesday August the 16 These 24 hours came with a light breeze from the S.W. and fine weather ship under all sail. Steering S.W. all the watch employed on ship duty at 12 Midnight light breeze at 10 AM. As this day calm and thick weather later part continued the same so comes.
 Wednesday August the 17 These 24 hours came with a light breeze and hazy weather ship under all sail at 2 P.M. wind held to the S.W. and rainy took in the fore and main topgallant sail. Thrust hoisted the yards at 4 P.M. Let the hook out and took the topgallant sail later part fresh breeze so comes. Long 172.00
