Sunday
Sept the 16

These 24 hours comm. with fine
breeze from the NW and heavy
weather ship under full sail
Sailing to the SE with
employed on ship's duty at 2 PM
Went ship to the NW at 6 PM
Tuck in sail for the night
Middle part light breeze at 6 AM
Main sail and went ship to the
NW later part light breeze and
breezy weather to Endeavour

Lat Bygd 34.52

Monday
Sept the 17

These 24 hours comm. with slight
breeze from the NW and
breezy weather ship under all
sail by the wind to the westward
Nothing in sight at 6 PM Tuck
in sail for the night Middle part
light breeze at 6 AM made all
sail on the wind to the NW
later part heavy to Endeavour

No other this day

Tuesday
Sept the 20

These 24 hours comm. with slight
breeze from the NW and rain
at one PM Tuck in the foremast
sails Nothing in sight at 6 PM
Tuck in sail for the night
Middle part fresh breeze from
the NW at 6 AM made sail
and steered to the southward at
6 AM saw sail to the south
steering to the south saw four

Lat Bygd 35.43 Five barrels whale later part
Long in 16.40 fresh breeze and fine weather

Clark Estes Master 1842

Wednesday
Sept the 18

These 24 hours comm. with fine
fresh breeze from the NW
and fine weather ship under
all sail sailing with employed
on ship's duty at 2 PM spoke
the French ship Victor of Bourne
14 Monters not within see of oil
at 6 PM shoten sail for the night
Middle part light breeze at 6 AM
made all sail steered to the
NW at 9 AM Tuck in sail for
Long in 17.00 the NW later part fine weather

Lat Bygd 34.55

Thursday
Sept the 22

These 24 hours comm. with fine
breeze from the NW and cloudy
weather ship under all sail
steering SE with employed on
ship's duty and sail in sight
at 6 PM Tuck in sail for the
night at 6 AM made all sail
steered to the NW at 9 AM
spoke the ship Silas Kirkwood
of Sag Harbor with 1750 of oil
later part light breeze to Endeavour

Lat Bygd 34.51

Friday
Sept the 23

These 24 hours comm. with slight
breeze from the NW and heavy
weather ship under all sail
by the wind to the NW and
in sight to the north at 6 PM
Tuck in sail Middle part light
breeze at 6 AM made all sail

Lat Bygd 35.16 Steered West later part light
breeze and calm to Endeavour
at 10 AM saw four whale boats with no crews
