

Ship Novena of Fall River 1842

Middle Irish breeze at 6 AM
Maid sail saw whale at 7 AM
Load saw boats broken Boat
Struck and circle went Boat stem
and circle sound but the line
came on a signal but the whale
at 9 AM with up the west Boat
Whale at 10 AM began cutting
at 12 Meridian finished cutting

Lat 43° 36' N
Long 17° 51' W

Friday
Oct the 26

These 24 hours calm with a light
breeze from the south ship under
all sail & spary all hands on
deck on voyaging 4 ships in sight
at 6 PM took in sail fore the
right middle part calm at 6
AM maid sail at 7 AM began
stowing down at 12 Meridian finished
so ended

No. This Day

Saturday
Oct the 27

These 24 hours calm with a light
breeze from the North and breeze
Weather ship under all sail by the
wind to the westward at 2 PM saw
Whale board three boats and chase
with out success at 4 PM board the
boats with out success at 6 PM
took in sail fore the right all
the work employed voyaging Middle
part light breeze at one AM
Went ship to the S. & S. E. at 5 AM
Maid sail at 7 AM began stow
ing of Bottom Pecks at 9 AM
finished voyaging later part hazy
Weather so ended

Sunday These 24 hours calm with a light
out the 30 breeze from the W. & W. and hazy
Ship under all spary sail
Fore whaling at 2 PM saw whale
Load three boats with out
success at 3 PM board with the
same at 6 PM took in sail fore
the right middle part Irish
breeze at 6 AM maid sail is
being hazy at 7 AM began stow
ing down later part Irish
Weather so ended nothing in sight

Monday These 24 hours calm with a light breeze
out the 31 from the W. & W. and thick
Weather ship under double reef
topsails heading to the North at 3
PM finished stowing down set the
main sail at 6 PM took aboard
three ship with 1000 of oil took
in sail Middle part Irish gale
at 5 AM maid sail and stow
Lat 43° 36' N of E. & E. at 10 AM took in S. E.
Long 17° 51' W later part Irish gale so ended

Tuesday These 24 hours calm with a light
November then gale from the south and thick
Weather ship under double reef
topsails heading to the Eastward
all the work employed on board
Saw from at 2 PM saw one whaling
Whale gain fast to the westward at
6 PM went again topsails and
took in sail Middle part
