 Sails Stand to the S.W. later
 Long in 16 1/2 Part light Breeze so ends

Sunday Dec 11 These 24 hours come with a light
 Breeze from the S.W. and fine
 Weather Ship under all sail
 At 2 PM Began Towing down
 At 3 PM saw whale boat three
 Boats Tow Boat struck and
 Towed at 3 PM Finish Towing
 down Tuck in sail Ship to the
 S.W. Middle Part light Breeze
 At 4 AM Made sail Stand
 At 5 AM saw whale boat
 At 6 AM saw whale boat
 Three boats Chased with out
 success Later part Irish breeze

 Weather at one PM Tuck in the
 Main topgallant sail at 2 PM

 Chased with out success at 3
 PM Tuck in sail Middle
 Part light breeze at 4 AM Made
 sail Stand to the S.W. later part light
 Breeze so ends

 Tuesday December 13 These 24 hours come with a light
 Breeze from the S.W. and hazy
 Weather Ship under all topsails
 At 2 PM wind held to the South
 Inequal Tuck in the gill and
 Main sail Tuck in the
 Top and Main topsail Tuck in
 the Mizzen topsail Stand to the
 Middle Part Irish gale at 4
 PM Made all sail Stand
 Long in 16 1/2 West later Part Irish Breeze so ends

Wednesday Dec 14 These 24 hours come with a fine
 Breeze from the Eastward and
 Hazy weather Ship under
 all sail Towing fast at 4 PM
 On Bent the fore sail and
 Bent another at 8 PM Tuck
 in sail from the right at 4
 AM Made sail Stand to the
 At 9 AM saw whale boat
 three Boats west Boat struck
 Harbor Boat Circle at 10 AM
 Tuck the whale to the Ship
 At 11 AM Began cutting at 11 PM
 Long in 16 1/2 Finish so ends

Thursday Dec 15 These 24 hours come with a fine
 Breeze from the S.W. at 2 PM
 saw whale boat three Boats
 Carried and west Boat struck at
 At 7 PM began cutting at 11 PM
 Finish one whale at 1 AM began
 in the other at 6 AM Finish the
 ship later part Calm so ends
