 topsail later part continued
 Lat Byob 47.14 The same at 12 midnight the
 wind held to the S.W. so ends

Sunday Jan the 1st These 24 hours Com: with a fresh
 breeze from the W.S.W. and cloudy
 weather ship under double reef
 fore topsails heading to
 the South at 2 PM set the
 main sail light breeze
 at 7 PM Shorten sail
 for the night Middle part
 fresh wind at 4 AM made sail
 Lat Byob 48.50 at 8 AM were ship to the S.W.
 Long in 175.22 later part fresh gales so ends

Monday Jan the 2nd These 24 hours Com: with a fresh

 Lat Byob 49.14 heavy swell running at 4 AM
