 Tuesday Jan 3rd These 24 hours come with a
 light breeze from the S.W. and
 cloudy weather ship under
 all sail heading W.S.W.
 At 7 P.M. shorten sail for
 the light Middle Part
 A light breeze from the East
 At 4 A.M. made all sail stand
 Last Bygone 47° 00' W. Lat. Saw several fin backs
 Longitude 17° 37' Later part fine breeze and hazy sea

Wednesday Jan 4th These 24 hours come with a fine
 breeze from the Eastward
 and hazy weather ship under
 all sail steering W. by N. nothing
 in sight watch employed on
 ship's duty at 7 P.M. shorten
 sail for the light at 10 P.M.
 Tuck in the fore sail and hoist
 in at 4 A.M. made all sail
 No do this day Stead W. by N. later part hazy
 weather so ends

Thursday Jan 5th These 24 hours come with a fresh
 Gale from the Eastward and
 thick hazy weather ship
 under all sail steering W.S.W.
 at 4 P.M. hold up. Stead at 5
 P.M. Tuck in sail and hold
 in the S.W. Middle part thick
 weather at 4 A.M. made sail
 Stead S.W. by S. later part
 foggy the day continued thick and hazy
 so ends

Clark Estes Master 1843
 Thursday Jan 6th These 24 hours come with a
 light breeze from the S.W.
 and thick weather ship under
 all sail heading W.S.W. and
 played on ship's duty as we have
 crossed the Meridian 160° we started
 away on day to make the time
 come weight at 7 P.M. shorten
 sail for the light Middle
 Part light breeze at 4 A.M. made
 all sail stand south later part
 Last Bygone 47° 00' W. Lat. Sailed with a fine breeze
 Longitude 17° 00' E. ends with a fine breeze

Friday Jan 6th These 24 hours come with a light
 breeze from the S.W. and fine
 weather ship under all sail
 steering South saw several fin
 backs at 7 P.M. Tuck in sail
 for the light Middle part
 light breeze at 4 A.M. made sail
 Last Bygone 47° 00' W. Lat. Ship to the S.W.
 Longitude 17° 00' E. later part fine breeze so ends

Saturday Jan 7th These 24 hours come with a fresh
 breeze from the S.W. and fine
 weather all the week employed
 on ship's duty mending sails
 At one P.M. were ship to the
 North Outh kept the topsails
 At 7 P.M. Tuck in sail for the
 light Middle part fresh gale
 at 4 A.M. set Outh reef topsails
 Last Bygone 47° 00' W. Lat. later part heavy gale Tuck in
 on again so ends
