 Thursday April 20th These 24 hours came with a
 light breeze from the South
 and variable winds with thick
 weather ship under all sail
 heading to the Eastward at 3 PM
 wind held to the S.W. Middle
 Part light breeze and thick weather
 then wind held to the W.S.W. set
 the fore and fore topmast stunsail
 Lat 45.46.5 Sail and Steer E by S later
 Long 122.31.40 Part Irish gale and thick weather

Friday April 21st The first part of this day
 began with fresh gale from
 the W.S.W. and drizzly weather
 ship under all topsail
 steering East at 4 PM set the
 fore topmast stunsail
 Middle part Irish breeze at 3 PM
 wind held to the West set the
 fore stunsail at 10 AM wind
 held to North shifted the steering
 sails Steer E by S later part fine
 breeze and cloudy weather to East
 Lat 46.07.5

Saturday April 22nd The first part these 24 hours
 light breeze from the North and
 cloudy weather ship under
 all sail steering E by S at 5
 PM huck in the steering sails
 thrust up Steer East at 7 PM
 huck in the fore and main
 Lat 46.5.35 Topmast sail Middle part
 Long 120.52.40 Thick weather at 10 AM wind
 held to the W.S.W. set steering sails

 Sunday April 23rd These 24 hours came with a fresh
 breeze from the W.S.W. and thick
 drizzly weather ship under
 all sail steering E by S
 At 9 PM wind held to the North
 huck in the fore topmast stunsail
 sail at 10 PM wind commencing
 huck in the fore and main
 topmast sail Middle part
 Irish wind and Rainy at one
 AM huck the fore sails
 At 6 AM made all sail wind
 at 8 PM at 10 AM set the fore
 Lat 47.11.40 fore topmast stunsail later part Irish
 wind at 10.5 PM Variation 12 Point East

Monday April 24th These 24 hours came with a fresh
 wind at W.S.W. and thick drizzly
 weather ship under all sail
 steering E by S at 3 PM Steer
 E by S at 5 PM wind shifted
 to the W.S.W. at 7 PM wind held to
 the W.S.W. Middle part Irish breeze
 from the S.W. and thick weather
 At 10 AM wind held to the North
 Lat 47.16.5 huck in the fore topmast stunsail
 Long 144.24.00 sail later part with a fresh wind
 11.20.55.40

Tuesday April 25th These 24 hours came with a fresh
 wind from the South and thick
 weather ship under all sail
 steering E by S Middle part Irish
 breeze at 6 AM set the fore topmast
 Lat 47.32.00 steering sail later part Irish breeze
 Long 109.33.00
