 Long 89° 10' W Sailed later part Irish breeze S.E.

Wednesday May 3rd These 24 hours begins with
 Irish breeze from the S.W.
 And cloudy weather Ship under
 In all sail Striving S.E. & at
 2 P.M. Set the fore topmast Striving S.E.
 Middle part Thick Drizzle
 Weather at 7 AM wind commencing
 Lat 52° 07' S Tuck in the topgallant sails
 Long 86° 05' W Later part Irish gales from the
 S.W. Barometer stands 30.1 in
 Variation 1/4 East

Thursday May 4th These 24 hours come with Irish
 gales from the S.W. and thick
 Cloudy weather Ship under
 All sail Striving S.E.
 Middle part thick Drizzle
 Weather wind at 8 AM Lat
 4 AM Tuck in the fore and
 Main topgallant sail
 At 5 AM Dribble Reef the
 Main topsail Tuck in the
 Lat 54° 08' S Gibb and Main sail
 Long 82° 12' W Later part thick weather
 Barometer at 29.8 in

Friday May 5th These 24 hours begins with
 Irish gales from the S.W.
 and thick Drizzle weather
 Ship under Single Reef topsail
 Striving S.E. & at 2 P.M. Head
 E.S.E. at 4 P.M. Dribble Reef the
 fore topsail at 5 P.M. Set the
 fore and main spinnaker Middle
 part Thick Drizzle weather

Sat this Day at 3 AM Set the Main sail at
 Lat 55° 27' S Sailed at 4 AM let out the main
 55° 27' S Sailed at 4 AM let out the main
 Long in 79° 11' W Later part Part thick weather

Saturday May 6th These 24 hours come with a light
 breeze from the S.W. at 2 P.M.
 Wind held to E.S.E. at 3 P.M. were
 Ship in the South Middle part
 Part Calm with thick
 Weather at one AM a light
 breeze from the E.S.E. were Ship
 To the South at 9 AM were
 Lat 56° 17' S Ship to the S.E. & later part
 Long 80° 25' W Light breeze and pleasant weather
 So ends Variation 2 miles East

Sunday May 7th These 24 hours come with a
 light breeze from the S.E. and
 Pleasant weather Ship under
 All sail Striving on the
 Wind to the East Middle part
 Long 75° 31' W Fine breeze and pleasant weather
 Lat 57° 05' S at 10 AM Dribble Reef the topsails
 Long 75° 12' W Later part Irish gales and thick weather
 So ends Variation 2 1/4 East
