Latt 45° 43' 1" Part Thick gale later part com
Long 45° 43' 0" Tinned the same to carry Valdivia 1843

May 17th Gale from the S.W. and Squally
Weather Ship under all
Reef Topsails String S.W. E
At 10 P.M. let one Reef out the
Topsails Mizzen part Main and
Fore set gill and main sail
At 6 A.M. Main with sail wind
Latt 46° 34' 5" At S.W. later part Fair Breeze
Long 46° 12' 0" From the S.W. Barometer 27.50

Thursday These 24 hours come with a fine
May 18th Breeze from the S.W. and
Cloudy weather Ship under all
Sail String S.W. E at 10 P.M. Tuck in
the Main topgallant sail and
Sent out the flying gill Booms
and sail Mizzen part Calm
At one P.M. wind at S.E. set the
Latt 42° 47' 5" Star String sail at 2 P.M.
Long 41° 43' 0" Wind holds to the S.E. Tuck
Long 40° 18' 0" In the Lead String sail

Friday These 24 hours come with a
May 19th Fine Breeze from the S.E. and
Cloudy weather Ship under
all sail String S.W. E all
The watch employed in Ship's
Duty Mizzen part light breeze
From the S.W. shifted over the
