Saturday These 24 hours come with a fine
May 20th breeze from the S.W. and
cloudy weather Ship Under
All Sail Storing S.E. & S.
All the watch employed on
Ships Duty Middle part Light
Breeze and fine weather at 3 PM
Wind west set fore and main

at 4 PM Set fore and main
Sail at 5 PM Part of the day clear with a light
Long 36° 11' 0" Breeze and clear Variation 4° E

Sunday These 24 hours come with a
May 21st light breeze from the west and
cloudy weather Ship Under all
Sail Storing S.E. & S. all
The watch employed on Ships
Duty Middle part Light Breeze
At 2 AM wind hauled to the North
Tuck in the Storing Sails

Lat 36° 05' 5" Later part Calm but a distance
Long 36° 46' 0" by measuring the Sun from
Crown 3 PM 16' 0" The Moon Variation 4° Point East

Monday These 24 hours come with a light
May 22nd breeze from the N.E. and
cloudy weather Ship Under all
Sail by the wire to the Eastward
Middle part Calm

at 7 AM Turned all hands
to Storing Sails at 11 AM
Lat 37° 54' 5" but a distance between the Sun
Long 36° 54' 0" Later part Calm
So ends

Tuesday These 24 hours come with a calm
May 23rd and pleasant weather Ship Under
all Sails all hands employed
on Storing Sails from 2 PM Middle
Lat 37° 26' Part Calm Later part Calm
Long 36° 20' 0" Weather and Calm

Wednesday These 24 hours come with Calm
May 24th and fine pleasant weather Ship
Under all Sails all the watch
employed on Ships Duty at 3 PM
at light breeze from the Westward
Ship Storing S.E. & S. at 4 PM Set fore
and main Sails Middle part
Wind hauled to the S.W. Tuck in
the Storing Sails Later part fine
Lat 35° 54' 5" Breeze and pleasant weather
Long 38° 47' So ends Variation 4° Point East

Thursday These 24 hours come with a fine
May 25th breeze the S.W. and pleasant
weather Ship Under all Sails
Storing S.E. & S. all the watch
employed on Ships Duty at 5
PM Surgeon Cadet Jack Tuck
Went to the Rigging and ~~at 11 AM~~
Middle part fine breeze and fine
weather at 5 PM wind hauled
at 6 AM Tuck in the fore topgallant
Sail at 9 AM Tuck in the main
topgallant sail at 10 AM Double
Lat 33° 39' 3" Reef the topgallant Later part fine
Long 36° 36' Gale from the S.W. & S. ends
