June 1st These 24 hours comm. with a calm
and fine pleasant weather
Ship under all sail, which
employed our ships duty, and
bent the fore topsail and
bent another at 7 AM Tackled
Ship to the ESE wind North
At 11 AM saw a large ship
striking to the SE comm. with
squares of wind and rain.

Friday

June 2nd

These 24 hours comm. with
fresh gales from the North
and cloudy weather at 2 PM
Doubt if the topsails ship
Heaving ESE Middle part
fresh gale and squally with
Lat 21.26 S Hair Later part continued
The same SE winds Variation half
point westerly

Saturday

June 3rd

These 24 hours comm. with a
fresh gale from the NNE
and squally weather Ship
under Doubt if the topsails
Heaving to the NE at 2 PM
Tackled from the west
Heave up the main sail
Settle down the topsails at 4
PM Moderate head sail upon
Middle part fresh breeze at 6
AM saw the Island of Irianaid.

Having 8 PM distance 20 miles
Wind held to the SE set string
sails

Sunday These 24 hours comm. with a
June 4th fresh wind from the SE and
fine weather Ship under all
sail string NNE all the
which employed our ships
duty at 8 PM wind held to the
SE shifted over the string
sails Middle part fresh
breeze at 9 AM saw a sail to
Lat 17.10 S the SE Later part fresh Trades
Long 29.10 W fine weather Variation 1/2 west

Monday These 24 hours comm. with a
June 5th fresh Trades from the SE and
fine weather Ship under
all sail string North
Middle part fresh Trades and
passing clouds Later part
Lat 14.07 S continued the same
Long 32.46 W under Variation 1/2 point west

Tuesday These 24 hours comm. with fresh
June 6th Trades from the SE and fine
weather Ship under all sail
string North all the which
employed our ships duty
Middle part fresh Trades and
squally at 5 AM Tackled in the
Squally string sails at 7 AM
Tackled in the flying gill at
9 AM Tackled in the fore topsail
existing sail wind held to the
Lat 11.35 S ESE Later part fresh wind
Long 35.10 W fine weather SE winds
