 Lat 1 02 1/2 Later part fine breeze and pleasant
 Long 84 40 1/2 Weather so ends Variation 7 1/2 west.

Sunday The first part of these 24 hours
 June 11th came with a fine breeze from the
 ESE and pleasant weather
 ship under all sail steering
 N 1/2 E all the watch employed
 on ship's duty at 7 PM Shorten
 N 1/2 E Middle part fine breeze
 and pleasant weather
 Lat 1 05 1/2 Later part continued the
 Long 86 40 1/2 Same so ends

Monday These 24 hours came with a
 June 12th fine breeze from the ESE and
