PM Calm at 10 PM heavy shower
of rain at 6 AM began to watch
ship at 6 AM a light breeze from
S.E. all the string
sails. Later part fine breeze
and pleasant S. E. ends

At 5 PM finished churning. Ship

later part light breeze and
variable S. E. ends. These 24

breeze and variable at 2 AM
tuck the S.E. Traction and
