 Saturday These 24 hours come with
 July 4th slight breeze from the west
 and variable ship under all
 sail stowing 8 PM all
 the work employed on ship
 duty at 4 PM calm at 5 PM
 slight breeze from the west
 Middle part light breeze and
 Lat 29° 00' Variable Later part continued
 The same so comes left of painting

Sunday
 July 5th These 24 hours come with a
 light breeze and variable all the
 the compass with signs of rain
 thunder and lightning at 4 PM
 squally at 5 PM wind at 6 PM
 set the flying jib & fore topgall
 set sail Middle part light breeze
 and cloudy weather at 5 AM
 saw three sails at 9 AM speak
 the *Thigg* Emily of Waller brought
 down from Boston bound
 Lat 30° 00' Narragansett Providence with five
 Long 66° 00' Passengers on board Later part
 calm so comes

Monday
 July 6th These 24 hours come with slight
 breeze from the NW and very
 hot weather at 1 PM set the
 stowing sails all the work
 employed on painting ship
 Middle part light breeze and
 Lat 31° 38' squally Later part fine breeze
 Long 66° 39' so comes

From *Severaland* for *Waller*
 Tuesday These 24 hours come with
 July 4th spin breeze from the West
 and fair weather ship under
 all sail stowing 8 PM all
 the work employed
 on ship duty Middle part
 squally at 10 AM speak a
 Swedish *Thigg* her name was
 Lat 33° 23' 26 PM Later part light breeze
 Long 69° 00' so comes

Wednesday These 24 hours come with a
 July 5th light breeze from the westward
 calm at 3 PM a light
 breeze from the eastward at
 4 PM a light shower of rain
 here to help the rain
 Middle part squally with rain
 at one AM a light breeze
 from the Westward Later part
 Lat 34° 30' all the work employed on
 Long 69° 37' painting ship so comes

Thursday These 24 hours come with a light
 July 6th breeze from the Westward
 and fair weather ship under
 all sail stowing 8 PM all
 the work employed on paint
 ing ship at 6 PM took in
 the stowing sails Middle part
 fine breeze and pleasant weather
 At 5 AM took a squall from
 the NW took in the topgall
 Lat 35° 37' sails at 6 AM made all sail
 Long 70° 23' Later part took in sails so comes
