Sail and Scudair in 75 Fathoms
of water on the Banks at 9 P.M.
Shorten Sail Duble Reef the
Topsails Tuck in the gill and
Main Sail Later part foggy so ends
75 Fathoms of water Harbours 29th

These 24 hours Com. with a brisk
Breeze from the S.W. and foggy
Ship under Duble Reef Topsails
steering S.W. by W. at 4 P.M. set gill
and Main Sail at 9 P.M. Squally
Tuck in the Fore and Mizzen Topsails
Middle part Squally at 4 A.M. made
Sail at 8 A.M. thick weather Duble
Reef the Topsails wind hble to the
