 Trades and Squally Ship under
 all sail Storing to & from all the
 Work Employed on Ship's duty
 at 10 P.M. made *Brook* bearing
 W by S dist 25 miles at 10 P.M.
 double reef the Tapsir and how
 at back head *McCarrie* of *Shore* at once
 at 11 P.M. were ship to the S by at
 5.30 A.M. made sail and Stead
 fore *Brook* later part Calm
 at 6 P.M. came to anchor in the
 Port of *Lahaina* in the 17
 fathoms of water pulled the
 sails so ends this way By
 level & course
