

Ship's Journal of Fall River 1844
 Wednesday June the 14th
 There 24 hours calm with light breeze and calm ship under all sail went for get the fog two sail in sight all the watch employed on ships duty boiling boom middle part calm at 4 AM made all sail stand N to W later part foggy so ends

Thursday June the 15th
 There 24 hours calm; fish breeze from the eastward and thick weather ship under all sail showing & boiling in sight at 6 PM shorten sail head north in gross water middle part heavy later part foggy weather saw one whale so ends

Friday June the 16th
 Calm with fish gales from the eastward and foggy ship under. Coast reef topsails and fore sail at 6 PM were ship to the south middle part calm at 8 PM fore ship to the north at 4 AM made sail later part foggy so ends

Saturday June the 17th
 There 24 hours calm; with fish breeze from the eastward and foggy weather ship under all sail showing nothing in sight but one Porpoise middle part light breeze at 4 AM set all sail at 5 AM saw one whale had three boats with our crews all the watch employed on boiling boom later part fine weather

Sunday June the 18th
 There 24 hours calm; with slight breeze from the north and pleasant weather ship under all sail eastward of Bristol at 4 PM saw one whale had three boats struck and killed at 7 PM took the whale to the began cutting gut through lips middle part fine weather at 3 AM began cutting at 6 AM finished later part foggy



Monday June the 17th
 There 24 hours calm; with slight breeze from the WSW used foggy all hands employed on boiling and scraping boom middle part calm and foggy later part continued the same so ends

Tuesday June the 18th
 There 24 hours calm; with slight breeze from the SW and fog ship under. Hole topsails head to SW all the watch employed on boiling at 6 PM shorten sail middle part calm at 6 AM foggy at 7 AM set hole topsails later part calm and foggy so ends

Wednesday June the 19th
 There 24 hours calm; with slight breeze from the WSW toward SW at 3 PM finished boiling at 7 PM took in sail for the night middle part calm at 4 AM began straining down later part calm and foggy finished straining down so ends

So ends to day
