These 24 hours comm: with a fresh breeze from S.S.W. and a heavy swell one saw several sails, some to windward and some to leeward - and a game of Whales. Middle part more moderate. Latter part light breeze from S.E. and foggy - saw 5 Whales to the windward 4 miles off so ends this day -

These 24 hours commences with a light breeze from S.E. and sun fog at 3 P.M. spoke the Ship Tuscarora of Cold Spring with 2 Whales along side. 1600 - middle the same. Latter part fresh breeze from South and sun fog - so ends this day -
