

Ship *Provena of Fall River 1844*
 Wednesday August 14
 There 24 hours Corn with a light
 Breeze from the Sward fair weather
 All hands employed on boiling
 An whaling board three times
 With out Lumps at 7 PM Tuck
 in sail for the night Middle
 Part light breeze were ship to the
 NW at 7 AM were ship to the SE
 Later part thick weather & clear

Thursday Aug 15
 There 24 hours Corn with a light
 Breeze from the SW and thick
 Weather Ship heading SE all the
 Work employed on boiling saw three
 Whales Middle Part light breeze from
 The South At 6 AM made sail &
 began showing down the main back
 At 9 AM saw whales head three boats
 Cut part and all three dead later
 Part foggy & clear

Friday Aug 16
 There 24 hours Corn with light
 Breeze from the South and foggy
 At 5 PM finished boiling at 7
 PM Tuck in sail Middle part
 were ship to SE at 7 were ship
 to the West later part thick fog

Saturday Aug 17
 There 24 hours Corn with fresh
 gales from the SW and thick
 Weather Ship under short sail
 Middle Part continue the same
 At 7 AM began showing down the fore
 Backway at 10 AM made sail at 12 AM
 finished showing down later part foggy

Ship *Enter Master 1844*
 Monday August 18
 There 24 hours Corn with light
 Breeze from the West and foggy
 Ship under all sail heading to
 The SE nothing in sight at 7 PM
 Shorten sail for the night Middle
 Part light breeze from the SE & thick
 Weather at 5 AM made sail two
 Ships in sight saw plenty whale
 Long 160 216 said three times with out Lumps & clear

Tuesday August 19
 There 24 hours Corn with a light
 Breeze from the SE & fine
 Weather Ship under all sail All
 hands employed on whaling at
 4 PM was beat struck and cut
 At 7 PM shorten sail Middle
 Part calm At 8 AM made sail
 Thick and foggy At 6 Leave two boats
 With out Lumps later part thick

Wednesday Aug 20
 There 24 hours Corn with light breeze
 from the Eastward and thick weather
 At 8 PM speak the ship Latona
 of New Bedford 2400 two ships in at
 sight at 7 PM Tuck in sail Middle
 Part Tacking at 9 AM set double top
 Top sail later part fresh gale Tuck in
 sail & clear

Thursday Aug 21
 There 24 hours Corn with fresh gale
 from the E & E and Hailing ship under
 double heading to the SE Middle
 Part fresh gale Tuck in the fore sail
 Later part fresh gale from the SE
 Long 160 418 Ship head SE & clear
