Islander in sight. Lat 30.. 12 South.
Long 80.. 34 West

Light breeze from S.E. and squally
all sail set steering N^W by W. Spoke the bark
Islander this afternoon. Saw St Felix
bearing N^W by E at 35 miles distant.

Monday Feb 12th

Light breeze from S.E.
Ship lying off and on St Felix two
boats went a fishing. caught several.

Light breeze from S.E. and fine
weather all sail set steering N^W by N
the watch employed breaking out black
smiths coal and coopers oil.

Light wind from E. and fine
weather all sail set steering S^W.

Long 82.. 56 West

Thursday Feb 15th

Light breeze from S.E. and
fine weather all sail set steering S^W.
the watch employed hanging ship's bell.
Lat 19.. 49. Long 84.. 13

Light breeze from S.E. by E. and
fine weather all sail set steering N^W by N.
Lat 18.. 14 South
Long 85.. 46 West

Saturday Feb 17th

Light breeze S.E. all sail set
steering N^W by N. the watch employed
scrapping and painting iron work.
Lat 16.. 33 South
Long 87.. 24 West

Sunday Feb 18th

Light breeze from S.E. all sail
set steering N^W by N.
Lat 14.. 49 South
Long 89.. 02 West

Monday February 19th

Light S.E. trades and fine
weather all sail set steering N^W by N
the day employed setting up the shrouds
and backstays. Lat 13.. 12 South
Long 91.. 06 West

Tuesday Feb 21st

Light trades and fine weather
all sail set steering N^W by N
the watch employed raling down the
lower rigging.

Long 93.. 00 West
