

Ship St George from New Bedford to S J
Friday March 23rd

Light S.E. trades and fine
weather. Saw Hawaii 11 AM. bearing
West at 60 miles distant.

Saturday March 24th

Light trades and fine weather
all sail set steering N by E. saw Maui
bearing N.W. the Bark Cicero in sight.
At 8 o'clock P.M. let go anchor in the
Port of Lahaina.

Sunday March 25th

Ship St George at Lahaina S.J.
One watch ashore on liberty.

Monday March 26th

The day employed getting
a raft of water.

Tuesday March 27th

The day employed getting
a raft of water and landing 6 cases
of tobacco.

Wednesday March 28th

The day employed loading
out and stowing down and putting
freight on board the Schooner Active.

Thursday March 29th

Ship St George at the port of
Lahaina. One watch ashore on liberty.

Friday March 31st

Ship St George at the port of
Lahaina. One watch ashore on liberty.

Saturday March 31st

The day employed cooping
the Oil for shipping.

Sunday April 1st

Ship St George at the port
of Lahaina. One watch ashore on liberty.
Five of the men ran away, three were
captured.

Monday April 2nd

The day employed cooping
the Oil and putting it on board the
Schooner Active.

Tuesday April 3rd

The morning employed
getting sweet potatoes and a raft
of water. got under weigh at 2 o'clock
and started ^{for} Kawaihi with a light
breeze from N.W.
