Strong breeze and cloudy weather from S.W. Ship under whole topsails steering N.W. by E. At one o'clock last night there was a large Right whale turned flukes just a head of the ship.

Sunday April 29th

Strong wind and cloudy weather from N.W. it is quite cool to day we have had a fire in the drying room for the first time.

Lat 40.. 51 North
Long 170.. 34 East.

Monday April 30th

Calm all day. We killed the big hog. He weighed 228-lbs dressed. I eat his tail for supper it was very nice. Lat 41.. 30 North
Long 171.. 49 East.

Tuesday May 1st 1866

Fresh breeze from S.E. by E. and cloudy weather all sail set steering N.W. The watch employed making sausage. we killed two sheep for the crew.

Lat 43.. 14 North.

Wednesday May 2nd

Strong breeze from S.E. all sail set steering N.W. we have had a thick fog all day but it has partly cleared away now.

Thursday May 3rd

Strong breeze from S.E. with a thick fog. killed two sheep for the sailors.

Friday May 4th

Strong breeze from S.E. with a thick fog. Ship under topsails and foresail steering N.E. by E.
