First part light breeze from
S.E. Latter part strong breeze from S.
ship under topsails and courses
steering by the wind. there are a great
many birds around.

Tuesday May 8th

First part strong breeze from
S. Latter part moderate breeze and
fine weather from S. Tacked ship at
12 M.

Lat 36.. 00.
Long 171.. 17.

Wednesday May 9th

Light winds and calm
with fine weather. there are a great
many birds around.

Lat 36.. 23
Long 170.. 48

Thursday May 10th

First part light winds and
calm. Latter part fresh breeze from
S.E. all sail set steering by the wind.
there are a great many birds of
different kinds around the ship.

Lat 57.. 12 North
Long 171.. 08 East.

Friday May 11th

First part strong breeze from
S.E. Latter part light from S.W. with
a light snow storm which lasted
about an hour.

Lat 58.. 45 North
Long 171.. 30 East.

Saturday May 12th

First part light breeze from
S.W. Latter part strong breeze from
S.E. with cloudy weather all sail
set steering by the wind. sail in sight.

Lat 58.. 31 North
Long 172.. 14 East.

Sunday May 13th

These 24 hours light wind
and cloudy weather with frequent snow
squalls. three ships in sight.

Monday May 14th

First part light breeze from
S.W. Middle & Latter part light breeze
from S.W. all sail set steering S.
Two ships in company. there is land
in sight bearing S.W. at 30 miles
distant, Lat 60.. 12. Long 173.. 31 East.
