

Sunday June 10th

First part light breeze and clear weather at S.E. middle part saw whales, toward 4 boats without success. Latter part fresh breeze. 22 sails in sight 3 of them boiling. Spoke the ship *Reindeer*. Capt Kaynor struck a bowhead yesterday but lost him.

Monday June 11th

First part blowing strong with cloudy weather at S.W. middle & Latter part light breeze 14 ships anchored in the ice.

Tuesday June 12th

First part light breeze and fine weather from north. gained with the Bark *Kae Kaurai* of Honolulu. Middle & Latter part light breeze and clear weather.

Spoke the brig *Kohola* of Bremen. She picked up a dead whale yesterday.

Wednesday June 13th

First part light breeze and fine weather at S.W. gained with the bark *Martha*. Capt Thomas. Middle & Latter part light breeze. Spoke the ship *Arnold's* Capt Hawes. says the ship *Goat Group*. took a bowhead yesterday.

Thursday June 14th

Light breeze & thick fog at A.W.B.W.

Friday June 15th

First part light breeze and clear weather at A.W.B.W. all sail set. steering 11 sails in sight. Middle & Latter part light airs and calms with thick fog. Bent the cable to the port anchor.

Lat 64. 22. North.

Long 177. 23. West.

Saturday June 16th

Begins with fresh breeze and clear weather at N. 20 sails in sight two of them boiling. middle & Latter part light breeze and thick fog.

Sunday June 17th

Begins with strong breeze and thick fog at N. saw a bowhead going quick

Middle & Latter part strong breeze and cloudy weather. 6 sails in sight. 1 of them boiling.

Lat 64. 20 North.

Long 177. 44 West.

Monday June 18th

Begins with strong breeze and clear weather at S.E. gained with the bark *John P. West*. Middle & Latter part light breeze and clear at W. ship working N.W. through the ice. we saw two bowheads this morning, toward but without success.
