

Sunday July 22nd 1866

First part fresh breeze and clear weather at NW. Middle & latter part light breeze and fine weather. 3 sails in sight. Lat 69.. 48 North. Long 163.. 13 West.

Monday July 23rd

Light airs and calms. Middle & latter part fresh breeze and fine weather at NW. Two sails in company. Lat 69.. 48.. North

Tuesday July 24th

Begins with fresh breeze at W. gamed with the ship for Group & bark Courser. Middle & latter part strong breeze at N.E.E. Lat 70.. 29 Long 163.. 02

Wednesday July 25th

Begins with strong breeze at NW. Middle & latter part moderate breeze and clear weather. at 10 AM run off the SW. 6 sails in sight.

Thursday July 26th

Begins with light airs and calms the watch employed looking walrus blubber gamed with the ships for Group Gay Head & bark President & Courser. Middle & latter part blowing a gale at SW. Ship Gay Head in company

Friday July 27th

First part blowing a gale at SW. at 6 PM it moderated. spoke the bark Gloriosa of San Francisco. Middle & latter part moderate breeze. 5 sails in sight.

Saturday July 28th

Begins with light breeze and thick fog at W.S.W. at 5 AM. it lit up spoke the ship James Murry. Middle part thick fog and rain. latter light breeze and fine weather at SW. Lat 70.. 27

Long 174.. 15

Sunday July 29th

Begins with light breeze and clear weather. gamed with the Gay Head. 9 sails in sight. Middle and latter part light breeze and thick fog at S.E.

Lat 70.. 43 North.

Long 174.. 36 West.

Monday July 30th

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at NW. spoke the bark Mary of New Bedford. Middle & latter part fresh breeze and fine weather. at 10 AM saw a low head toward and stand him but the iron came out. 20 sails in sight 4 of them boiling. Herald's island bearing W.B.L. 20 miles distant. Lat 71.. 04 North.
