

Thursday August 9th 1866

Begins with fresh breeze and thick fog at N.B.C. middle & latter part light breeze and thick fog ship lying off and on the ice
Lat 71.. 00 North.
Long 174.. 47 West.

Friday August 10th

Begins with light breeze and thick fog at W.B.N. at 3 P.M. it cleared up, saw 24 ships two of them boiling and three whaling. Middle & latter part light breeze and foggy. Gamed with the ship Northern Light. Capt. Clough says the bark Roscoe left the ground on account of being stove by the ice.
Lat 71.. 11 North.
Long 175.. 10 West.

Saturday August 11th

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at W.M. spoke the bark Daniel Wood of New Bedford. Middle & latter part light breeze. Gamed with the ship Congress of New Bedford. Several ships whaling. 24 ships in sight.
Lat 70.. 47 North.
Long 172.. 51 West.

Sunday August 12th

Begins with light breeze and fine weather at W.M. Loward for whales but did not get any. Middle & latter part strong breeze and foggy. 25 ships in sight.
No Observation.

Monday August 13th 1866

Begins with strong breeze and foggy weather at N.B.C. middle part gamed with ships Northern Light, For Group, Ocean, Congress, Arnolda, and bark Massachusetts. Loward three times for whales to day without success. 30 sails in sight.
Lat 70.. 47 North.
Long 171.. 11 West.

Tuesday August 14th

Begins with fresh breeze and foggy at S.B. Loward for a whale to day. Middle & latter part light breeze and fine weather. 27 sails in sight.
Lat 71.. 00 North.

Wednesday August 15th

Begins with light airs at S.B. gamed with the ships For Group and Champion. at 7 P.M. saw a whale going quick toward for him. Middle & latter part fresh breeze rainy weather at S.B.
No Observation.

Thursday August 16th

Begins with light breeze and foggy at S.B. Middle & latter part light breeze with snow squalls.
No Observation.

Friday August 17th

Begins with breeze light and snow squalls at N.B. gamed with the bark Addison. latter part toward twice for whale but did not get any. Gamed with Arctine
